New Emergency Manager For Dodge County

Dodge County has appointed its new emergency manager, replacing Bill Pook, who retired and whose previous office, the Region 5-6 Emergency Management Office, is set to be discontinued.

Thomas Smith will take over the new position, which will be under the jurisdiction of Dodge County, as opposed to the several counties who made up the interlocal agreement that oversaw Region 5-6.

The board voted to leave that interlocal agreement in May. The original agreement had actually expired in 2008, and Pook said that the structure had become unsupportable in recent years.

Smith was the Region 44 Emergency Management Coordinator out of Fullerton, Nebraska, and also served on the Nebraska National Guard's Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear response team. He was an emergency management regional coordinator for Systems Plus Inc., serving as a consultant for Nebraska's Army National Guard commands.


Morse Code Display
