Two Special Test Nets For ARES

Two special sessions of the Dodge County ARES Net on the 146.67 MHz repeater in Fremont (Dodge County NE) were held in support of the NWS Tornado Drill on Wednesday, March 27, 2019.

The first net was activated at 1001 AM when I received the Test Tornado Watch. This net lasted 5 minutes and had 8 check-ins.

The second net was activated at 1016 AM when I received the Test Tornado Warning. This net lasted 7 minutes and had 8 check-ins.

The Test Tornado Watch and Test Tornado Warning were received in multiple ways at my home, including NOAA Weather Radio and Omaha TV. I did not have time to monitor all the stations. There was also an HF net operating on 3.982 MHz, which is I believe is the first time that HF has been used during the tornado drills.
