PIONEER AMATEUR RADIO CLUB MINUTES FOR OCTOBER 28, 2021

The Pioneer Amateur Radio Club Meeting for October 28, 2021, was held at Hero's/Gambino's in Fremont. The meeting was called to order at 7 PM by President Tony Renze, K0OMH. Twenty-three people were present, who introduced themselves.

PROGRAM: Steve Narans, WB0VNF, and Tom Smith, Dodge County Emergency Manager, went over two drills. The first was a Dodge County drill in which PARC/ARES set up the Emergency Trailer for support. The second drill was a PARC/ARES drill to simulate a tornado hitting Fremont causing associated problems. Tom presented Steve an award for his work on both drills.

MOTION TO PAY BILLS: Sharon Martens, KB0TVB, paid an additional bill of \$15 for chicken at the picnic.

EDUCATION: No report.

FIELD DAY: Chairman K0OMH said that next year's event is scheduled for June 25-26, 2022, at Izaak Walton Park in Fremont. He will check on the reservation. He is also interested in doing a Winter Field Day on January 29-30, 2022. He will check on the availability of Camp Calvin Crest. Dan Steinhoff, W7UP moved that \$150 be available if needed. WB0VNF seconded the motion, which was approved.

FLEA MARKET: Co-Chairperson Rich Mehaffey, KB0ARZ said that next year's event will be a week later than usual on July 16, 2022, due to another event scheduled at the North Bend Auditorium. He also mentioned the Norfolk Hamfest on November 20.

PICNIC: TBA in 2022. KB0TVB and W0NRW Chairpersons.

CHRISTMAS PARTY: Scheduled for 530 PM on December 4, 2021, at the Fire Barn in Waterloo with Linda Kirchmann, W0ZIP and Jane Mehaffey, KB0ZUN Chairpersons. Jim Muegge, W0JBM has paid the \$70 deposit, which he then donated to be used in the prizes fund. \$250 will be available for prizes on a motion by Ray McNally, N5SEZ, seconded by Mike Campbell, KE0KAZ, which was approved. A sign up sheet will be available in November.

HAM HISTORY

I got my start in radio in the 1950's by listening to AM and shortwave radio on my Dad's Zenith G500 receiver. While serving in the U.S. Army, I had access to Collins R-390A and Hammarlund SP-600 receivers and some substantial antenna farms which were great for shortwave DXing. I received my Novice license in 1972 and was assigned the call sign WN7UPP. My first station was a Hallicrafters SX-146 and an a Heathkit DX-60A transmitter with an 80/40 meter dipole. In 1974 I passed the Technician examination and was licensed as WA7UPP, and in the 1980's upgraded to General, then Advanced Class. In 1998 I finally was able to copy 20 WPM CW and passed the Amateur Extra examination, and in May 1998 received the call sign W7UP.

I still have the Zenith G500 receiver and occasionally use it to listen to Nebraska football games. I use a Kenwood TS -130S and loop antenna for 80 meter phone nets and a Yaesu FT-920 for the rest of my HF operations. My HF station antennas are a Cushcraft R8 vertical and an 80 meter End-Fed Half-Wave wire antenna.
