PIONEER AMATEUR RADIO CLUB MINUTES FOR MAY 27. 2021

The Pioneer Amateur Radio Club In-Person Meeting for May 27, 2021, returned to Hero's/Gambino's in Fremont. The meeting was called to order at 7 PM by President Tony Renze, K00MH. Twenty-six people were present, who introduced themselves.

MINUTES AND TREASURER'S REPORT: See the May 2021 PARC News. MOTION TO PAY BILLS: Sharon Martens, KB0TVB paid \$641.95 to Rich Mehaffey, KB0ARZ for the Flea Market Grand Prize. This was authorized at the April meeting.

HOSPITALITY: Sharon Martens. KB0TVB had nothing new to report. (*Anybody* knowing of somebody needing a card should let KB0TVB know. Her email address is posted on the PARC website.)

EDUCATION: Jane Mehaffey, KB0ZUN had nothing to report.

FIELD DAY: Scheduled for June 26-27, 2021. Don Renze, K0OM Chairman. PARC has the usual building at Izaak Walton Park reserved. A video of the 2017 Field Day was shown. Don will try to have us set up antennas on Friday, June 25, if it is OK with Izaak Walton. K0OMH, and possibly others, will stay all Saturday night. KB0TVB will obtain hot dogs. Pizza will be furnished Saturday noon. Dave Theophilus, W0NRW will make up the hamburgers. (The grill needs a gas tank but K00MH and Wesley Payne, KE0WHA have both offered to bring a tank.) Don asked people to bring extra coax. We will have the June PARC meeting to finalize details.

FLEA MARKET: Scheduled for July 10, 2021 in North Bend at the City Auditorium. Chairpersons Rich Mehaffey, KB0ARZ and KB0ZUN reported that the event will have 60 tables. Twenty-two more tables will be rented which we will need to set up on Friday. Ross Mehaffey, KOARZ will be in charge of the food in the *PARC Your Wagon Cafe*. He passed around sample menus, which will be similar to past years. (For a while it was feared that we might not have VE Testing due to the new FCC requirement that people have to have a FRN (Federal Registration Number) before testing. However, the person leading the testing, Monty Wilson, NR0A from Norfolk has said if need be, he will help a person obtain an FRN that day.)

PICNIC: Scheduled for September 26, 2021. KB0TVB and W0NRW Chairpersons. CHRISTMAS PARTY: Linda Kirchmann, W0ZIP and Jane Mehaffey, KB0ZUN Chairpersons. It was agreed to try to do what we had to cancel in 2020.

NET MANAGER: Mel Cunningham, K0VLA said he has Net Control Stations through May. He passed around sign-up sheets for Net Control

ARES: Steve Narans WB0VNF gave a short report on ARES activities. The new 220 repeater in the Courthouse is operational. It is owned by Wes Chrisman, KD0PGV. Steve will look into a group buy of 220 radios. (He did this. They have arrived, are being programmed, and are being distributed.)

PUBLICITY: WONRW said that when he notified the *Fremont Tribune* about the May meeting, they again printed the notice in their Calendar but also printed a brief notice about our return to Hero's/Gambino's. There was a discussion about publicity for Field Day and the Flea Market.

OLD BUSINESS: John Page, KE0CSH said there is a simplex net in Washington County on Tuesday nights at 7 PM on 147.42 MHz.

NEW BUSINESS: KE0WHA and Nina Stark, K0NSS said they will be doing some work on the W0UVQ repeater. This will be Don Renze's last year as Field Day Chairperson. Tony Renze, K00MH will take over from him next year. However, Tony would also like to step down as President as he has had that position for several years. (Volunteers line up!)

DRAWING: The winner of the \$10 was Sandy Cunningham, KB0TVA.

ADJOURN: The meeting was adjourned at 747 PM.
