The Fun Time


Field Day June 24-25, 2023



VARA Info From Matt

I've heard various folks discussing VARA and thought I'd post this here for reference.

For VHF users, there are 4 (four) VARA FM gateways in the area supporting Winlink - AL0R-8, AL0R-10, KD0IVV-10, and W0ZZK-10. These are shown on the Winlink map at https://winlink.org/RMSChannels then click on VARA FM in/on the map to show VARA FM gateways.

Additionally, there are at least 4 VARA FM digis as well - AL0R-9 (collocated with AL0R-10,) AL0R-7 (collocated with AL0R-8,) AL0R-5 (near Crown Point,) and W0ZZK-4 (collocated with W0ZZK-10.) Of these, AL0R-5 has broad coverage spanning a roughly 40 mile radius from near 72nd and I680. All AL0R nodes are currently on 145.07, while W0ZZK and KD0IVV are on 145.03. Both AL0R-8 and AL0R-10 are reachable from AL0R-5. A Fremont node is in the works.

For HF users, the AL0R RMS is on 80m, 40m, and 30m, for operators to connect to and is collocated with AL0R-10 if you'd like to have a local MPS reachable via VHF.

There are two pdf documents on at this link in the fileshare section offering more information on VARA in general, as well as the ALOR VARA network. https://bit.ly/44errvq (I'm not a Wix fan, but it is what it is.) These cover some Winlink, VarAC, and general information.
